- **Location:** a [village sign language](#) of India. It is spoken in the town of [Alipur, Karnataka](#), which is a self-imposed Muslim enclave with a high degree of congenital deafness in a largely Hindu region.
- **Language Use:** A substantial number of the hearing population of 17,000 knows the language.
