- Location: a [village sign language](#) of Turkey. It was originally spoken in the town of [Mardin](#), dating back at least five generations in a single extended family.
- Language Use: All speakers now live in [Izmir](#) or [Istanbul](#), and the younger generation has shifted to [Turkish Sign Language](#).
