EE201 LAB GRADING POLICY

Labs are worth from 20 to 30 pts each. Unless otherwise indicated labs are due at the beginning of the class corresponding to your lab's due date. For all due dates please see the class syllabus (for the F'11 semester most due dates are announced in class the day the lab is assigned). If you turn in the lab on time (at the beginning of class) and you are not ready to present at the beginning of the lab period (or the lab must be modified to make it operate correctly), the lab will be prorated by 3 pts (15% of 20 pts). If you turn in an operational lab, during the lab period, 2 pts (10% of 20 pts) will be deducted until 15 minutes before the end of the lab period. After this time Labs will be considered 1 week late and prorated by 4 pts (20% of 20 pts). Labs which are 2 weeks late will be prorated by 6 pts (30%). Labs will not be accepted after a two week period of time. These grade points represent the maximum grade you can receive on a lab. Your final grade will be determined by a number of factors, including but not limited to, (1) your write-up, (2) review of your lab notebook, (4) lab demonstration, and (5) following write-up/outline instructions. In summary, your final grade will be assigned based on work completed and your demonstrated level of understanding of the lab topic.
