

“Lyons Sign Language [lsg] (A language of France)

- **Location:** Rhône-Alpes region: Lyons city.
- **Language Status:** 6a (Vigorous).
- **Dialects:** None known. 405 km from Paris, but reportedly little intelligibility with French Sign Language [fsl].
- **Other Comments:** Very little information about it is available. Survey needed to determine if it is still used, and if so, what is its relationship to French Sign Language [fsl].”
