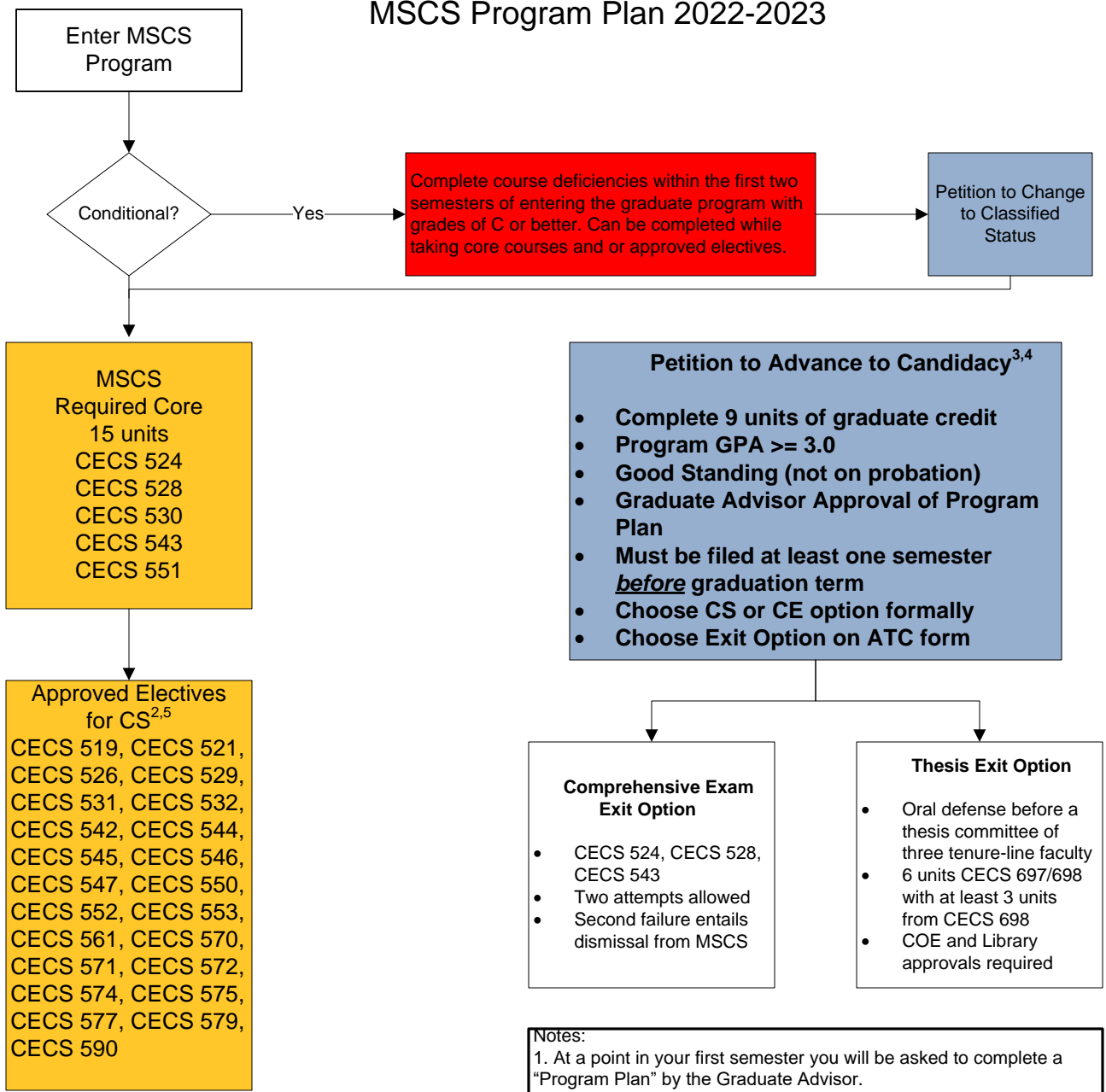


MSCS Program Plan 2022-2023



Notes:

- At a point in your first semester you will be asked to complete a "Program Plan" by the Graduate Advisor.
- Approved electives include up to 9 units of 400-level courses (rarely granted) approved by the Graduate Advisor on a class-by-class basis. Excludes all teacher related and project related 400-level courses.
- Only approved courses with a grade of C or better count towards the 30 units required for the MSCS degree. Retain a record of your ATC form. Any future deviate from the courses listed requires you to submit a "Change of Program Plan" form to the Graduate Advisor. Your transcript and ATC form MUST MATCH exactly or you will not graduate.
- ATC status is required to register for the Comprehensive Exam or CECS 697/698.
- All electives must be from the CECS courses listed here. Exceptions are rarely granted for electives outside CECS and must have compelling reasons.

Means students must submit documents to Graduate Advisor.
