#### **SELECTED STUDENTS WILL:**

- Commit to a two-semester internship and complete 450 hours of work (about 15-18 hours a week) while honing skills, exploring career opportuntities and networking
- Server Enroll in a 3-unit internship course during the Fall 2023 semester
- Attend professional development trainings and workshops
- Receive up to \$7,000 toward living expenses and a \$3,000 educational award
- Connect with other interns across the state via a virtual community platform and regional events
